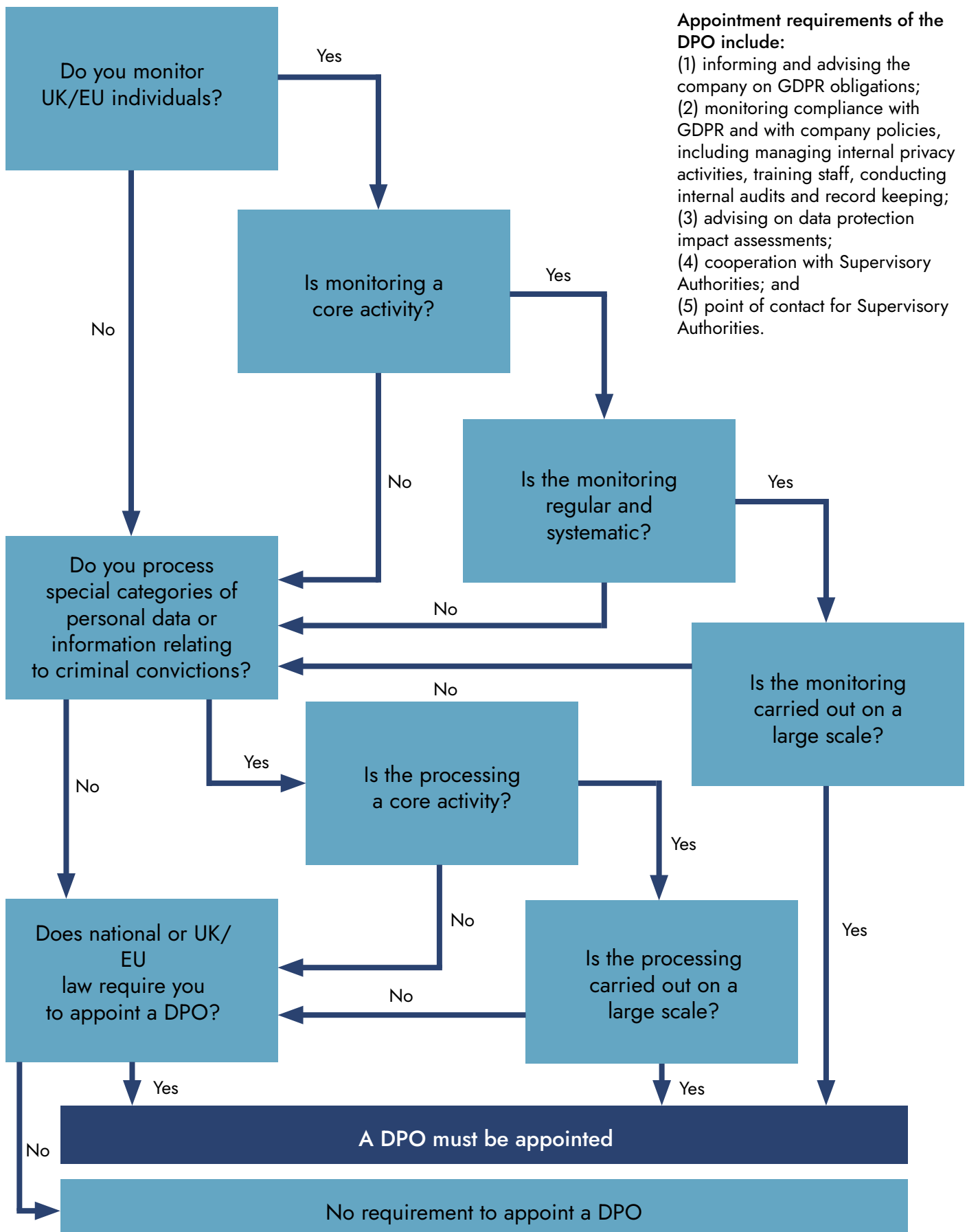


Do you need to appoint a Data Protection Officer under GDPR Article 37?



Appointment requirements of the DPO include:

- (1) informing and advising the company on GDPR obligations;
- (2) monitoring compliance with GDPR and with company policies, including managing internal privacy activities, training staff, conducting internal audits and record keeping;
- (3) advising on data protection impact assessments;
- (4) cooperation with Supervisory Authorities; and
- (5) point of contact for Supervisory Authorities.
